This specific position is a long term substitute position and entails teaching of two sections of Algebra 1 and one section of middle school mathematics. In addition, the long term substitute faculty member will fulfill all regular duties and commitments required of CCSC staff for a prescribed length of time, between mid-January 2019 and end of June 2019.

A long term substitute mathematics teacher can expect to:

- Assume personal responsibility for the academic progress of all students
- Work collaboratively to create and implement a program of study that is intellectually challenging
- Work with a diverse student body from Cambridge, Boston, and surrounding towns
- Sustain a school-wide culture of respect and actively use the school's Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS) system
- Plan and teach Algebra 1 and middle school mathematics sections
- Communicate with students' families on a regular basis
- Participate in myriad forms of professional development as scheduled for all faculty

Qualifications:

- Lead-teaching experience in mathematics preferred
- Teaching experience in a similar setting preferred
- BA or BS required; appropriate graduate coursework preferred
- Proper licensure preferred, but not required
