



Overview & Goals: *CCSC offers a broad array of extracurricular activities, student-led clubs and community partnerships to help students develop leadership, entrepreneurial and expressive skills outside the classroom. Through participation in extra-curricular activities, students can explore new interests and talents that balance and complement their academic work. CCSC teachers advise and supervise the clubs and coach the sports teams. Students can start a new club by finding a staff or faculty advisor and at least 5 interested students.*

Benefits: *Research shows that students who build a strong connection with their school and who participate in school activities tend to have higher grade point averages, better attendance records, and higher graduation rates. Extracurricular activities also foster community by bringing together students across grades, providing opportunities for teachers to know and mentor students outside of class, and building school pride.*

Extracurricular Activities

American Mathematics Competition (AMC): Students complete challenging math problems against other high schools. Honors math credit offered. Open to High School students only.

Art Club: To provide opportunities to create art, present art in different forms and visit and experience art in a variety of venues and settings outside school. Open to all students.

CCSC Players (Drama): for performance-oriented students to have the opportunity to develop and demonstrate creative skills in front of CCSC community. Open to all students.

CCSC Band: Musically inclined students come together with their personal instruments. Promotes teamwork through music. Performances at community meetings. Open to all students.

Chorus: Create joy, build community, and grow leadership within our school through song. Open to all students.

Constitution in the Classroom: BU law students come teach students about law and its relevance to students' lives. Open to all students.

Cooking Club: Encourages healthy eating by teaching students how they can prepare meals in a healthier way. Open to all students.

Meetings: Tuesdays, 131. MS and HS switch every other week.

Dance Team: Promotes healthy physical activity, teamwork and empowerment through dance. Open to all students.

Female Mentoring: Program provides a safe space for female students to establish long standing, authentic relationships with adult role models and engage in honest and vulnerable dialogue about the challenges of growing up. Open to all students

Male Mentoring: Program provides a safe space for male students to establish long standing, authentic relationships with adult role models and engage in honest and vulnerable dialogue about the challenges of growing up. Open to High School students only.
Meetings: Every other Thursday, 330

Mathcounts: “strives to engage middle school students of all ability and interest levels in fun, challenging math programs to expand academic and professional opportunities.” Open to middle school only.
Meetings: Fridays @ Lunch, 307

Math Club: Students learn how to use Bootstrap, a curriculum and software package that teaches children to program their own videogames using purely algebraic concepts. Opportunity for honors math credit. Open to all Students.
Meetings: Mondays, 335

Mock Trial: To facilitate public speaking skills and orient students to jobs in the legal profession. Open to 8th – 12th graders.
Meetings: Saturdays 9am – 12pm, Bent 204

National Honors Society: National organization that provides practical meaning to society’s standards of scholarship, leadership, service and character. Juniors and seniors are selected to apply based on their cumulative GPA. There is then a selection committee that selects students based on an application and the four characteristics.

Outdoor Club: We provide our students with opportunities to explore the outdoors while promoting environmental stewardship. Students plan and organize a few trips such as hiking, camping and canoeing. Open to all students.

One Problem at a Time (OPT): Student run organization that organizes community service projects and events to make our community a better and more peaceful place. Open to all students.

Poetry Slam Team: Are you Down To Write (DTW)? Because CCSC’s new Poetry Slam team is! Come express yourself, practice public speaking skills and potential to compete.

Pride Acceptance Circle (PAC): To make the CCSC community a safe space for GLBTQ students and their allies through support and social and educational events. Open to all students.

Robotics: Encourage student interest in science, technology, engineering and mathematics. Open to 8th – 12th grade. Opportunity for 6th and 7th to join in the spring.

Student Ambassadors: Students establish and maintain relationships with CCSC’s target audience, the media, and other opinion leaders. You will get to participate in media & event interviews, serve as tour guide for prospective students among others. Open to high school students who have attended CCSC at least 1 year.
