



Long Term Substitute ELL Teacher (part-time)

This specific position is a long term substitute position and entails teaching ESL classes to a variety of grades and language levels. In addition, the long term substitute faculty member will fulfill all regular duties and commitments required of CCSC staff for a prescribed length of time, starting immediately through mid-March 2018.

A long term substitute ELL teacher can expect to:

- Assume personal responsibility for the academic progress of all students
- Work collaboratively to create and implement a program of study that is intellectually challenging
- Work with a diverse student body from Cambridge, Boston, and surrounding towns
- Sustain a school-wide culture of respect and actively use the school's PBIS system
- Plan and teach multiple sections of ESL class to EL students at all language levels.
- Support EL students at all language levels in general education classrooms
- Develop an appropriate (aligned with DESE standards and guidelines) curriculum that supports rapid language acquisition for English Learners at all language levels
- Work with classroom teachers to support Sheltered English Instruction.
- Communicate with students' families on a regular basis
- Participate in myriad forms of professional development as scheduled for all faculty

Qualifications:

- Mass. certification in ESL grades 5-12
- Knowledge of methods and materials for teaching ELs
- Experience developing curriculum for English Learners
- Master's degree in TESOL, Applied Linguistics or related field preferred
