

Long Term Substitute Spanish Substitute Teacher (Full-time)

This specific position is a long term substitute position and entails teaching Spanish 1 and Spanish 4 classes in preparation for success in college and the requisite standardized exams – AP Spanish and the SAT II. In addition, the long term substitute faculty member will serve as an advisor and fulfill all regular duties and commitments required of CCSC staff for a prescribed length of time, between mid-August and November, 2017.

A long term substitute Spanish teacher can expect to:

- Assume personal responsibility for the academic progress of all students
- Work collaboratively to create and implement a program of study that is intellectually challenging
- Work with a diverse student body from Cambridge, Boston, and surrounding towns
- Sustain a school-wide culture of respect and actively use the school's PBIS system
- Design and implement lessons that promote growth in students' language proficiency above accuracy
- Serve as an Advisor to a small group of students
- Communicate with students' families on a regular basis
- Participate in myriad forms of professional development as scheduled for all faculty

- BA or BS required; appropriate graduate coursework preferred
- Teaching experience in a similar setting preferred
- Ability to teach any level of Spanish (Spanish 1 - AP Spanish) preferred
